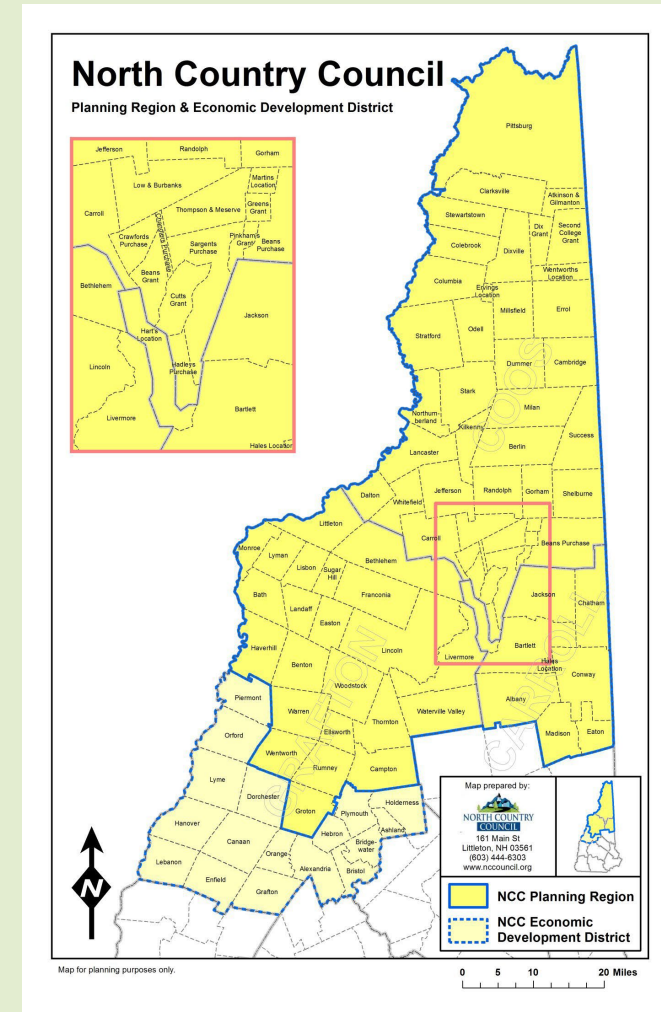

2020 REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN

- Updated every 5 years
- Multi-modal plan covering regional transportation needs, issues, and opportunities
- Basis for Ten Year Plan priorities + supporting outside funding requests
- Helpful reference for communities
- Addresses infrastructure, transportation services, land use, and other topics
- Covers NCC planning region
- Project finish line: summer/fall 2020



COORDINATED PUBLIC TRANSIT AND HUMAN SERVICES TRANSPORTATION PLAN

- FTA-mandated plan that enables FTA grant funds that support rural transit and transportation service providers (TCCAP, Transport Central)
- Specific to public transit and transportation services
- Covers NCC planning region + all of Carroll County (Lakes RPC)
- Project finish line: June 2021 (hopefully sooner)

CURRENT/RECENT STATEWIDE EFFORTS

- **Ten Year Plan update** + survey/public hearings (finishes summer 2020)
- **Statewide Strategic Transit Assessment** + survey (finishes fall 2019)
- **Statewide Pedestrian and Bicycle Transportation Plan** + survey/public outreach events (finishes Winter 2020)
- **Statewide Freight Plan** + survey/public open houses (finished spring 2019)

OPPORTUNITIES + CHALLENGES

- Regional transportation plan/Coordinated Plan need to be built using input from communities, partners, and the public
- Many recent/ongoing public engagement efforts related to transportation
 - Opportunity: significant existing data/public input
 - Challenge: don't want to overwhelm public with surveys, events, etc
 - Challenge: statewide efforts may not fully capture local/regional perspectives

PROPOSED APPROACH

- Strategic outreach with local/regional stakeholders (e.g., health and human service organizations, public health networks)
- Online public input opportunities – survey, review/comment on corridor profiles, draft plan materials
- Meet with interested community boards
